STATIONERY 2026

To ensure that you do not incur unnecessary expenses, we herewith provide the 2026 stationery requirements. We have approached various suppliers to ensure that these packages are available as affordably as possible.

The clothing shop will have the complete **stationery packages** available per grade from Monday, 27 October 2025.

Grade 4	R680
Grade 5	R615
Grade 6	R795
Grade 7	R1 040

We highly recommend that every learner acquires a HAT and an Oxford South African English School Dictionary (for use at home) as this is a long-term investment and can also be used in high school. For spelling and language development to reach its full potential, every learner must have access to a dictionary. However, since each classroom already has a complete set of dictionaries, learners do not have to bring **dictionaries** to school.

Students receive **textbooks and workbook covers**, so you do not need to purchase them.

All stationery must be clearly marked and brought to school on Wednesday, 14 January 2026 (excluding files). The textbooks received must be **covered** with thick plastic and are only on loan to the learner for the year. If a learner loses or damages a textbook, which is school property, you are responsible for replacing it.

"**Tipp-Ex**" is prohibited and will be confiscated if brought to school, as it has caused in the past damage to desks, books, and other stationery.

All Grade 4 to 7 learners are required to have the prescribed **school bag**, which is only available at the clothing shop.
